FlyMe adding new route between Malaga and Stockholm and starting international service from Malmö earlier than previously announced

FlyMe is introducing yet another new destination from Stockholm Arlanda. At the end of February, FlyMe plans to begin flying to Malaga. At the same time, international traffic from Malmö Sturup with flights to Nice and Alicante will begin in time for the February school holidays.

In October, FlyMe announced its new flight program for the summer of 2007 with several new destinations from Göteborg Landvetter, Stockholm Arlanda and Malmö Sturup. As announced, the new services include international traffic from Sturup beginning in March 2007 with flights to Bologna, Nice and Alicante. Flights to Nice and Alicante will now begin in February, which means that FlyMe's customers from southern Sweden will be able to enjoy the February school holidays in warmer latitudes. The number of flights is the same as before with departures to and from Nice on Wednesdays and Saturdays, and to and from Alicante on Saturdays.

"We've seen considerable interest in southern Sweden for just these two destinations. It feels nice that we can begin flying to these Swedish favorites as early as February 17. This means that many people can travel during the school holidays," says Mats Jacobsson, commercial director for FlyMe Europe.

FlyMe has been flying to Nice and Alicante from Stockholm Arlanda since November, and in March, the first plane will be lift off for Rome. Beginning on February 24, those living in the Stockholm region will also be able to fly inexpensively to Malaga, another of FlyMe's most popular destinations, with departures every Saturday.

"We've received many inquiries from the Stockholm market about opening a direct line to Malaga, so we know that there's demand for a Swedish low-price alternative, something I'm naturally glad that we can satisfy. FlyMe is in an expansive phase and our goal is to continue providing low-price alternatives so that everyone who wants can fly price friendly. We're still looking at the flight program for next summer and the addition of Malaga may be followed by several exciting new destinations," says Mats Jacobsson.
