Traffic report FlyMe April 2006 – heavy increase of passengers

In April, FlyMe carried 86 400 passengers. An increase by 71 per cent compared with April of last year.

FlyMe's CEO, Fredrik Skanselid:

- The domestic routes are doing better and better, with a load factor of 67 per cent. Furthermore, the European routes have had a great start. We already have a load factor of 57 per cent which is an incredibly good result considering April was the first month for the new routes.

FlyMe's regular traffic domestic

In April, FlyMe's load factor increased by 13.8 percentage points, to 67 per cent, compared with April 2005.
