Traffic report for FlyMe December 2006

During December, the international traffic continues to show a positive development compared with previous year. Also, the domestic traffic continues to show growth and improved usage of capacity compared with previous year. The load factor for the total regular traffic was 56.2 percent.

Mats Jacobsson, Commercial Director at Fly Me Europe AB, comments on the report:

- The usage of capacity on the domestic traffic improved substantially in December compared with November. We are continuously working on balancing the traffic program between the international traffic and the domestic traffic.
