Traffic report for FlyMe November 2006 – still positive for international traffic

During November, the international traffic continues to show a positive development. The domestic traffic is also showing a growth. However, the load factor for domestic has decreased during November due to the increase in capacity compared with previous year. The load factor for the total regular traffic was 59,4 percent.

Mats Jacobsson, Commercial Director at Fly Me Europe AB, comments on the report.

“We have already seen a progress for the recently modified price structure for domestic and the launch of the Flex ticket. We have noted a positive development for the last weeks in November and are counting on a satisfying level of traffic for December.”

“It is gratifying to see that more and more people choose to travel with FlyMe. The international traffic continues to grow substantially compared to November of last year and the growth in the number of flown passengers greatly exceeds the growth in the number of chairs compared to last year.”
